The FWBG is 120 acres and includes 23 specialty gardens. Wander through a tropical conservatory, a forest boardwalk, a Japanese garden with koi-filled ponds, and a water conservation garden just to name few.

Thoughtfully designed with accessibility in mind. A main wheelchair-accessible path connects to major attractions. Manual wheelchairs are free, first come first serve and electric scooters are available for rent. A free shuttle runs every half hour and is wheelchair accessible. Relax and enjoy the scenery as you move between different attractions and gardens with ease.

Finish your visit at one of the multiple gift shops around the Garden or stop at the Rock Springs Café. The Café offers delicious bistro-style food and drinks. Whether you are looking for a latte, a glass of wine, or a garden-made lunch, the Café is the place to stop during your visit to the Garden.
